Cost is still only \$3.00 for Members and \$5.00 Non-members.

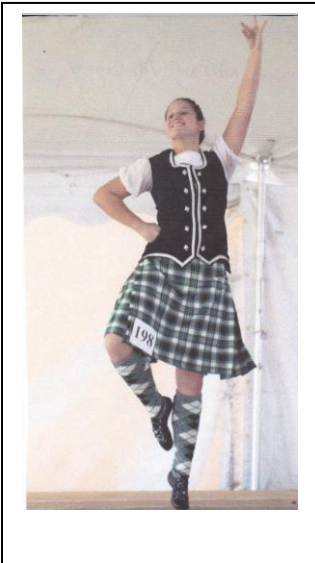




Mince & Tatties
